How to use this guide to plan your programme of study



At Lincoln, each qualification consists of a selection of individual courses.

Each undergraduate degree and diploma course is comprised of required, recommended and elective courses. Use this guide to work out what elective or recommended courses to take alongside the required courses.

Note: Times and teaching locations can change until the beginning of the semester.

To be on the safe side, check the website

www.lincoln.ac.nz/timetable

before your lectures start.

The first step is to decide which courses you will study during your qualification.

The second step, now that you know which courses you will study, is to populate your timetable on the Lincoln University website for your first semester.

Head to **www.lincoln.ac.nz/timetable**

Use the programme planner in this guide to list your preferred courses for each year.

Select your courses for Semester 1. Ensure you also select "Semester 1" from the "Week(s)" option. Choose either "Grid" or "List" from the "Report Type" option then select "View Timetable".

You now have your timetable.

Make sure to check back again before the start of the semester to ensure times or locations have not changed.

You may also need to make a note of laboratory or tutorial times once you have enrolled in your courses as these may not be listed in the timetable.
