# Study Abroad

As a Study Abroad student, you can take up to 30 ECTS of study per trimester. Each Deakin credit is the equivalent of 7,5 ECTS.

Trimester 2: 8 July - 18 October

Application deadline: 30 August

#### Cost

3 units /one trimester: AU\$ 7,590 4 units /one trimester: AU\$ 10,120

#### Eligibility:

- Must be currently enrolled at a university
- Must meet Deakin's English language requirements; IELTS score of 6.0 or TOEFL of 65 or satisfactory completion of the Deakin University English Language Institute test (a free test administered by a Deakin representative in your country).
