How does term intake work?

Step One – Enrol in an eligible course and commence study online in July, September or November 2020.

Step Two – Study two subjects per term and complete a total of four subjects (the equivalent of a full-time semester).


Step Three – Once you've completed your subjects, you can start your next semester at its usual commencement date.

Step Four – When travel restrictions are lifted and you've received your Student Visa, you can transition to study at one of our campuses across Victoria and New South Wales.¹
