

Fixed fees to ease your budget

To make it easier for students and their parents to budget, we are one of only a few UK universities that have introduced the same fixed fee for each year of your course for international students. If you start at the University in academic year 2018/19 you will pay the same fixed fee for each year of your course up to a maximum of four years.
